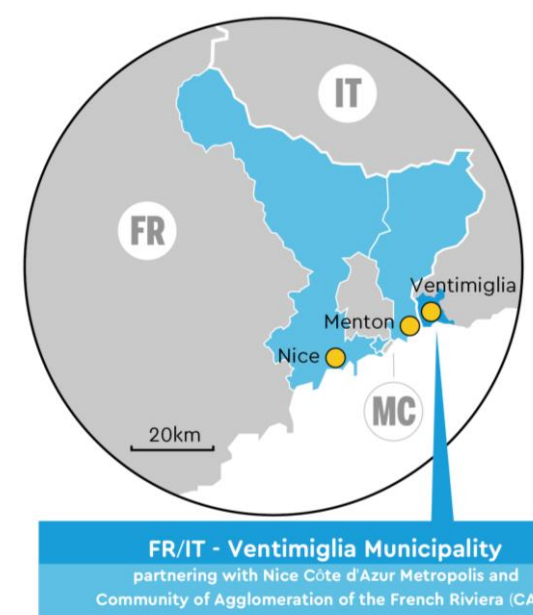

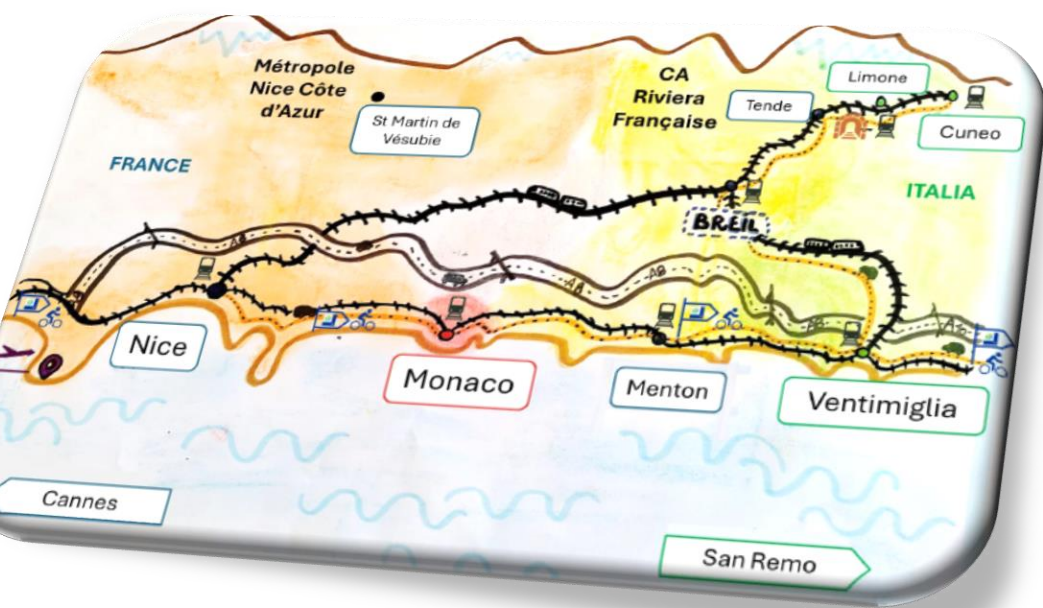
MAIN OBJECTIVES

- 1 Promote sustainable mobility
Across the Riviera region, aligning with environmental and social goals
- 2 Integrate land use & transport
Enhance coordination between spatial development and transport infrastructure.
- 3 Identify key challenges
Address existing bottlenecks, environmental concerns, and governance gaps.
- 4 Foster stakeholder cooperation
Build a shared vision to support future cross-border collaboration.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE PROJECT

- 1 Transport Infrastructure Mapping
Creation of a detailed inventory of existing transport infrastructure and services across the region.
- 2 Bottlenecks & opportunities
Identification of critical obstacles and development opportunities for sustainable mobility.
- 3 Stakeholder & governance analysis
In-depth stakeholder mapping and governance study to improve cross-border coordination.
- 4 Actionable mobility proposals for:
 - improved Intermodality
 - Electric vehicle (EV)
 - Infrastructure soft mobility networks (walking & cycling)
- 5 Integrated planning foundation
Laying the groundwork for a shared action plan integrating mobility and spatial development.
