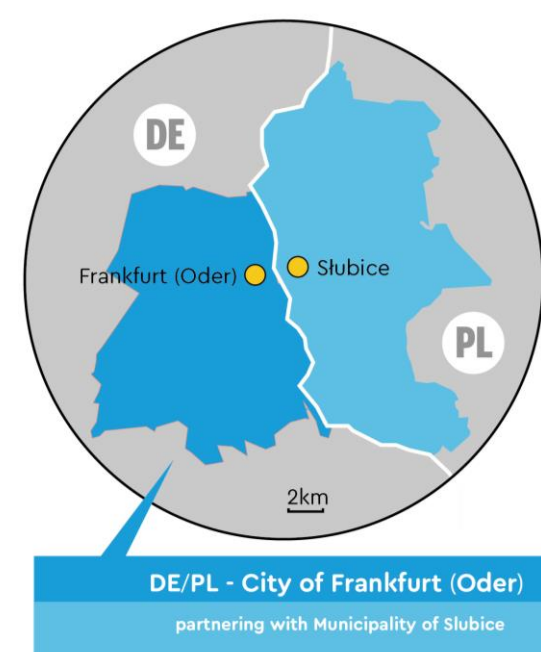

OBJECTIVES

Discussing the following topics together with experts from the region and beyond, from Germany and Poland, based on the structures established, strategies adopted and projects implemented over the last 15 years:



- What core potential for further development do Frankfurt (Oder) and Słubice have in the center of the German-Polish border region?
- Which priorities can be derived from this for the next ten years, where should resources be concentrated and networks strengthened?
- Which partners do we need to implement specific short- and long-term key projects?

RESULTS

- Broader and stronger involvement of key actors from politics, business, academia, and civil society,
- Establishment of a foundation for sustained cross-border cooperation and joint planning.
- strengthen joint inner-city development along the Oder and improve connections across the river.
- concept for a “European Center of Cross-border Competence”

KEY LESSONS

- The involvement of all levels: politics, economy, civil society, and administration is crucial
- Without these stakeholders, it is impossible to develop joint proposals for the development of city centers
- All participants agreed that the development of the centers of both cities is a common strategic task for spatial planning
- The differences between Germany and Poland mean that there is a real need to involve experts who are familiar with both systems
